Could *Pig* be the next *Memento*-esque indie puzzle flick?

Looking for the next *Memento*, *Seconds*, or *Timer*? Word has it the next twisty brain teaser flick to get excited for is *Pig*, the winner of the Sci-Fi London film festival's Best Feature award. Watch the first trailer now.

Pig — which is directed Henry Barrial and produced by Mark Stolaroff — is kicking up a lot of attention on the film festival circuit. Indie Wire dubbed this Kickstarter flick a project they were rooting for, and the film walked away with a very big prize at London's Sci-Fi film fest. The premise is reminiscent of some of our favorite memory-centric features like *Memento*:

A man wakes up alone in the middle of the desert with a black hood on his head and his hands tied behind his back. At death's door, he is discovered by a woman living alone in the desert and is nursed back to health. Upon regaining consciousness, the man realizes he has no idea who he is or how he got in the desert. His only clue, a piece of paper in his pocket with the name "Manny Elder" written on it, sends him on a journey to Los Angeles to discover his past. But things and people are not what they seem and clues lead to something bigger and more unusual than the man could have ever imagined.
